On Friday 10<sup>th</sup> October we are holding our annual 'Memory Banks Walk' - the Banks Road version of the Alzheimer's Society Memory Walk. The Memory Banks Walk will take place at 4.30pm – 5.30pm with the aim of raising awareness and funds for Our Dementia Choir and the Banks Road Legacy fund. The route is about 1.5 miles, starting and ending at school, and will be led by Banks Road staff. 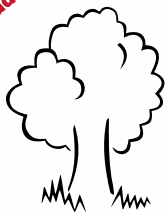
