Breakfast Club and After School Club

Dear Parents and Carers

At Banks Road Infant and Nursery School we are pleased to be able to continue to offer wraparound care in the form of our breakfast and after school clubs.

Who can attend?

Any child who attends Banks Road Infant & Nursery School and their siblings who attend Bispham Drive Junior School can attend the Breakfast and After School clubs.

Breakfast Club

- A healthy breakfast of cereal and toast and a drink of fruit juice or hot chocolate will be served. Children then are allowed either free play or adult led games and activities until it is time to go to the classroom.
- Breakfast Club opens at 7.30am and last entry is 8am. We will not be able to admit
 any children arriving after 8am, we must be very strict about this and children arriving
 after 8am will be turned away until school starts.
- We continue to offer a 'drop-in' service. You do not have to book in advance.
- Children who attend Bispham Drive will walk to school with a member of Banks Road staff in time for the start of school.
- The cost per session will be £5. We are now a cashless school. Payments should be made via childcare vouchers schemes or Pay360 where possible. We would prefer payments to be made in advance.
- Failure to pay in full for wrap around care services in a timely manner may result in the withdrawal of our services for your family.

After School Club

- Each week Afterschool Club has a different theme e.g. under the sea, transport, the 5 senses. Furniture, equipment and toys are provided for a range of activities. These include art, indoor and outdoor games, board games and puzzles, music and drama, reading and storytelling, imaginative play and quiet time such as television. The age of our children is considered so that activities are appropriate. We offer a range of activities to promote child development through play. There will be a balance of indoor and outdoor activities, weather permitting.
- Children will be provided with a light tea, prepared on the premises by our staff. The
 food will be healthy and nutritious and we will encourage a "family" type atmosphere.
 All food and drink will comply with dietary and religious requirements and with the
 school's status as a "Healthy School". Parents will submit an information form
 outlining any dietary requirements. Fresh drinking water is available to children at all
 times.
- Children will be collected from their classes at 3.15 pm, or 3.30 pm from the Nursery, and a register taken.
- Children from Bispham Drive Junior School with a sibling link at Banks Road are welcome to attend. In a similar format to our Breakfast Club, a member of staff will pick up children at Bispham Drive at 3:30 pm and walk them down to Banks Road.
- After School Club closes at 6pm. Late collections will result in a staff member waiting outside of the building with your child and additional charges being made. Regular late collections may result in the withdrawal of this service for your child.
- Sessions must be booked in advance. There will be a limit on the number of children who can attend After School Club. The form overleaf should be returned to school by 16th December 2022, and requests will be considered on a first come, first served basis.
- An invoice will be generated for the term. Sessions will be priced at £12. We would
 prefer for payments to be made in advance via childcare vouchers schemes or
 Pay360 where possible. We would prefer payments to be made in advance. No
 refunds will be given, however if your child is absent due to illness or other
 'exceptional circumstance' previously agreed with the head teacher, then we are able
 to add a credit to your account.
- Failure to pay in full for wrap around care services in a timely manner may result in the withdrawal of our services for your family.
- If your child has not previously attended After School Club you will be required to complete a contract and registration form. Unfortunately, without the completion of this form your child/children will not be able to attend.
